



Road Safety Technology, VIC

The road safety camera network is an integral part of the Victorian Government's road safety strategy which helps to ensure that Victorian roads are safe for all road users.

Road safety cameras are intended to deter drivers from exceeding the speed limit and failing to stop at red lights, by increasing the likelihood that a driver will be caught and punished for disobeying the road rules.

The road safety camera network consists of fixed and mobile cameras placed at carefully chosen locations throughout the Victorian road network, using specialised technology to detect offences.

To ensure that the road safety camera network operates continuously and provides consistently reliable incident data, all components within the network are subject to a systematic and rigorous testing, certification and maintenance regime.
